

# Millbrook High School Drama Booster Scholarship Application

## Application Process

- Students should fill out a written application packet (attached)
  - Include a professional acting resume with experience, education & skills (attach your headshot or a recent snapshot to this resume)
  - Include an essay outlining how you plan to use the scholarship money should you receive it and why we should award you the scholarship (500 words or less, double spaced typed)
  - Include at least two recommendations verifying work ethic and character. (Recommendations should NOT come from relatives.)
- During the interview, students should be prepared to showcase talent through a monologue performance (two one-minute contrasting monologues) or show a technical theatre portfolio (5 minutes)
- Have the application and all required materials to theatre instructor by March 1<sup>st</sup> of graduating year
- Your interview time and date will be set and mailed to you via US Mail shortly thereafter

## Scholarship Criteria

- Recipient should be a Millbrook High School Senior.
- Student should have at least a 2.5 Grade Point Average
- Student should have at least 2 years of theatre experiences on resume (This may be community or experiences from other schools for students who have transferred to MHS)
- During the senior year, student must participate in the theatre program in one of the following ways: enrolled in a theatre class, participates in a main stage production (either on stage or backstage)
- Student must be a member of the Millbrook High School Drama Boosters (minimum membership \$5)

## Selection Committee Guidelines

- The selection committee will be made up of parents who are members of the Millbrook High School Drama Boosters, along with the theatre instructor and technical theatre instructor of MHS
- Any parent who has a child that is applying for the scholarship should not participate in the selection committee.
- The selection process shall be completed in time for the scholarship to be awarded to the student by the Drama/Dance Awards Event and announced there.

## Award Distribution Process

- The scholarship will be awarded as a certificate to the student
- Scholarship payment will be made directly to school where student is attending
- The scholarship must be used within one calendar year from date of award

**To apply for scholarship, fill in the attached application and give all required materials to Mr. Kotzian by March 1<sup>st</sup>. If any of the above requirements are not turned in with your application - your application will be rejected.**
